## Cathedral Quarter Hotel offers Royal menu

Dine like the Queen...that's the invitation from the Cathedral Quarter Hotel, which last week launched the menu it concocted for royalty.

The Queen and Prince Philip enjoyed a meal at the hotel during their visit to the city on April 1<sup>st</sup>. The menu was created in careful co-operation with Buckingham Palace by the hotel's talented head chef, Dean Crews (left).

It starts with a pressed terrine of Ashover farm pork with Granny Smith apples and caper vinaigrette, followed by slow-cooked loin of Derbyshire lamb, cottage pie, peas and croquette potatoes, and a dessert of poached Yorkshire rhubarb and vanilla tart with cider sorbet.

The menu is available as an evening meal for £35 and dishes can be sampled for a supplement on the £15.95 lunchtime menu.

## 'Green' changes in the wind at University

The University of Derby has invested over £266,000 in three environmental energy projects - enough to boil 31,000 kettles or boil 91 laptops all day, every day, for a year.

A 200 metre square area on a roof at its main Kedleston Road site has been covered with photovoltaic panels to harness solar energy. Nine wind turbines have been fitted to the top of the South Tower and a further 75 ft wind turbine will be built on the main driveway over the summer.

The total amount of energy generated will reduce the University's carbon footprint by 18 tonnes. The projects follow a two-year, £13.5m refenestration and re-cladding of the three 1960s-built towers which has markedly improved heat and energy efficiency.
